## 1967

### The Sexual Offences Act 1967 is passed

which decriminalises homosexual acts between two men in private, who are aged 21 or over.

### The Wolfenden Report is published

containing a key recommendation to government that homosexual behaviour between two consenting adults in private should no longer be defined as a 'criminal act'.

## : 1969 77

The Stonewall riots take

- place in America,
- a catalyst for the rise of the modern
- LGBT liberation movement in the UK
- and beyond.

# **1969**

The Gay Liberation Front was founded,

with the aim of fighting for the rights of LGBT people.



## **1972** The first Gay Pride Rally takes place in London.

This has evolved into the annual Pride march.

## 2004 The Civil Partnership Act is passed,

allowing same-sex couples to enter into legal partnerships.

## 2004 💙

Gender Recognition Act 2004

gives transgender people full legal recognition of their gender.

## 2019

### Parliament votes to include LGBTQ+ content in the school curriculums across England.

and Wales (Scotland legalised gay marriage a year later in 2014).
